KUJWE DEVELOPMENT TRUST

in Siabuwa, Zimbabwe

The Kujwe Developmet Trust (KDT) was founded in 2017 in Siabuwa (Binga District), one of the driest and least developed areas of Zimbabwe, by the Tonga minority living there.



Their initiative aims to:

- Empowering vulnerable children through improved access to education
- Expand livelihood opportunities for women
- Improve health services

Various projects have already been realised:

- Bicycles for the girls whose way to school is longer than 6 km
- A laboratory for the school has been set up
- A tree nursery has been established
- As there is no access to the internet, a library was set up during the lockdown

Currently, four wells have been drilled and two tanks built for each of three schools, a clinic and the neighbouring settlements. Solar-powered pumps are still needed for this.

We want to support this project and others that arise from the KDT's own initiative.

DIGI-MECHANICS-SCHOOL

in Accra, Ghana

offers courses in digital car repair in its different variants.



The courses are addressed at workshop owners in the informal sector, trained mechanics, and apprentices. Addressed are young people who are interested in analysing digital defects of cars with the help of IT-technology to support the existing mechanics.

Initially, two 5-day courses will be offered:

"Basic Course" and "Advanced Course".

During the courses, cars are analysed and repaired for a fee. This income is not enough to finance the initial phase, but it will be able to sustain the operation of the courses in the future.

During the first 6 months, German experts will train the future Ghanaian seminar trainers.

Through this multiplier effect, many mechanics can be trained.
